## Beaded Bracelets

Make your own beaded bracelet or necklace just the Native Americans did when they lived in the Saginaw Valley years ago. Learn what beads were used for and who wore them?

## Pottery Making

Make your own clay object using a variety of techniques (please bring a container to take the object home in).

## Log Stamping

This was a technique used by logging companies to label ownership of logs. Students will be able to reenact this process using log stamps and inkpads.

## Tissue Paper Trees

Before the Lumbering Era, Saginaw County was covered with trees. Students can create a tribute to our environment history by creating a tree out of pipe cleaners and tissue paper.

## History on a string

Take a trip back into Michigan's history by put significant dates on a string time line, take it back to the classroom and continue to add dates to it as you study new things.
