**CASTLE MUSEUM TO UNVEIL *HISTORY ON THE MOVE*:
A MOBILE CLASSROOM FOR SAGINAW COUNTY CHILDREN**

The Castle Museum of Saginaw County History will begin taking history to the students of Saginaw County through its newest exhibit called *History on the Move*.

History on the Move is a unique “classroom” teaching local history in a modified tractor-trailer. **It will be shown to students for the first time Wednesday, April 21 at 10 a.m. at Ling Elementary School in Hemlock. All media are invited to attend this special event.**

History on the Move will bring our area’s heritage to life through hands-on, discovery-based programs tailored to the standards and benchmarks of Michigan. In addition to history, students will gain skills in geography, economics, science, math and language arts.

This mobile classroom provides an innovative solution to the lack of time and funding for students to visit museums during the school day. In short, the Castle Museum will bring a piece of its museum to the schools. It is free and available to all 14,000 Saginaw County public, charter and private elementary students in grades kindergarten through fifth.

The Historical Society of Saginaw County is committed to serve the community by telling the continuing story of the people of the Saginaw region through exploration, preservation, and presentation of their historical and cultural heritage. The Society operates the Castle Museum of Saginaw County History.
