Castle Museum Receives MCACA Grant

SAGINAW, Mich. – The Castle Museum of Saginaw County History has been awarded a \$20,000 operating grant from the State of Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs (MCACA). The grant was evaluated through the MCACA peer review process and was one of 598 applications to compete for MCACA 2018-19 fiscal year.

“We are honored to receive this funding from the Michigan Council for Arts and Cultural Affairs, and we appreciate that our local lawmakers value our continuing efforts to preserve and share Saginaw County's history,” said President and CEO Jonathan Webb.

The grant will be used to fund the museum’s operations including existing and temporary exhibits, building maintenance, events and improvements to *History on the Move (HOM)*, an award-winning mobile museum and classroom. *HOM* is a free program available for all Saginaw County public, charter and private schools.

“These funds provide crucial support to the Castle Museum,” said Webb. “We will continue to use them judiciously to bring the best programming possible to the citizens of Saginaw County.”
